ANNUAL REPORT 2019 - 20

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Introduction

School of Vocational Education, Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS SVE) has emerged as a system of imparting vocational education in higher studies. Though the system is based on German model, it has been developed in the context of Indian education system. This report will talk about the growth of SVE and how the model of skill education is established as a need of the hour. The report is prepared to give an overview of the school for the year 2019 - 20. At the beginning of the report details pertaining to the growth of the school are elaborated. SVE is constantly developing systems to enhance quality of the programme and lead to greater rigour in various academic and monitoring processes. The information of all such efforts is specified in the second part of the report. In the last part, vertical specific developments and testimonials of various stakeholders have been compiled along with interesting photographs to get a glimpse of the happenings in the year.




Growth of SVE from Year 2013 to March 2020



In the initial phase, the focus was more on establishing systems and developing various courses. Only a few courses had started. The progress was fast from year 2016 onwards because the students started graduating and started getting jobs. So the popularity of the programme increased. New hubs came on board. More and more students started enrolling in various courses. In the last three years there is no growth in the number of hubs as the non-performing hubs were closed and replaced with new hubs. Some verticals were closed down because of non-performance and hence the number of verticals is also reduced.



Students' Profile






Placement Details

Most of the SVE students are getting placement opportunities after completion of B.Voc. and PG Diploma courses. A number of professionals have also completed PG and other courses for enhancing their skills and qualifications. The placement details for the year 2019 - 20 are as follows:

Placement of B.Voc. students - Total 1626 students completed B.Voc. courses. Out of them 1266 received placement, 225 did not opt for placement and 117 students continued to look for appropriate placement. The students who are looking for placement are recent passouts. The students who did not opt for placements have gone for higher education or have joined family business. Some students did not opt for placements for personal reasons.

The students who received placement are getting salary in the range of Rs.10,000/- to Rs.30,000/- per month. The placement data in percentage is as shown in the following pie chart.




Percentage - Placement of B.Voc. Students (Total students - 1626)

Placement of PG Diploma Students – A total of 1414 students completed PG Diploma courses. Out of them 951 received placement, 455 did not opt for placement and 8 students are looking for placement. These 8 students have passed out recently. The 455 students who did not opt for placement are already employed and took admission to enhance the qualification. The course has helped them to get better opportunities in terms of better job position. The students who received placement are getting salaries in the range of Rs.18,000/- to Rs.55,000/- per month.




Percentage - Placement of PG Diploma Students (Total students 1414)

Placement of Students from Other Courses - This category includes undergraduate diploma and certificate courses as well as customized courses. A total of 4183 students completed Other Courses. Out of the total students, 186 received placement, 3981 did not opt for placement and 16 students are looking for placement. The 3981 students who did not opt for placement are already in jobs. They joined the certificate and customised courses to enhance skills that could help them to perform better in their jobs. The 16 students who are looking for placement are recently passed out. The 186 students who have received placement are getting salaries in the range of Rs.6,000/- to Rs.25,000/- per month.




Percentage - Placement of Other Courses Students (Total students - 4183)

TISS SVE – Key Support Functions



All the support functions of TISS SVE play a vital role in enhancing quality of the programme, conducting rigorous monitoring and making value additions. The key areas of new developments under these functions are elaborated in this section.

I) Content Development:

- Digital Content: This year SVE launched digital modules in the B. Voc. courses in collaboration with the Wadhwani Foundation. These were included in generic subjects "Communication Skills II" in Semester V and "Entrepreneurship and Employment Readiness " in Semester VI. A total of 1000 students completed the online module in Semester V and they appeared for an online examination in December 2019. This was the first attempt in SVE to deliver the courses through online mode. Henceforward, more and more subjects will be covered through online mode.
- Printed Content: In the academic year 2019- 20 total 1,60,454 books of different verticals were printed and sent to hubs. In 2018 -19 total 1,31,062 books were printed. This year more books were printed as the number of students and courses have increased.
- School Board Meetings and Academic Council Meetings Three meetings of SVE school board were conducted. The board members reviewed and approved curricula of four B.Voc. and three PG Diploma courses. Credit revision of eighteen PG Diploma courses too was approved. Subsequently all these courses were approved by the Academic Council (AC) of TISS. SVE courses were put up for approval in three AC meetings.
- Library at hubs: As a value addition 118 libraries were set up at the hub locations in the year 2018 19. In the current year 23 new libraries are added at the new hubs. Now the total number libraries are 141. This year a total of 575 library books were purchased and supplied to hubs. Total number of books purchased so far is 4749.
- Train the Trainers: TISS SVE has a pool of 943 trainers across all verticals at the hub locations. Three sixty trainers are teaching generic subjects and 622 are teaching vocational subjects.
 - Eight master trainers and 100 trainers from 50 hubs were trained by the Wadhwani Foundation for teaching digital content of the subject 'Communications Skills II'. Sixty six trainers were trained for semester 6 online modules on 'Entrepreneurship' and 'Employment Readiness'.
 - The training of other generic subject trainers was conducted online. In all, 300 trainers were trained till March 31, 2020. They are teaching subjects like Financial Literacy, Basics of HR and Law, Personal Grooming and Functional English. For the first time the training of trainers was conducted online which saved a lot of cost and time. Henceforward, the online training will be an ongoing activity which is a value addition by TISS SVE for hub partners.
 - Training of Vocational Trainers was conducted by the Vertical Anchors along with SVE team member either at hub locations or at a central location.
- **II) Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP)** This is a IT landscape that integrates the data management and operational activities of the various stakeholders and keeps a real-time tab on all activities of SVE. The key developments in the current year are as below:

- Accounts module: The process of payment advice and invoice management are automated based on preset criteria, which has reduced paper-based transactions and ensures end-toend transparency to all stakeholders.
- Communication Module has been introduced this year to facilitate easy communication between all stake holders using the ERP. Using this feature all ERP users can communicate to specific set of users regarding the actions to be taken or tasks to be completed through system notifications, SMS or emails.
- A Lead Management System is being implemented to ensure efficient routing and management of student leads from multiple sources such as SVE website, social media listings, walkins.
- The SVE website is being revamped to make it more informative and user friendly.

Thus the SVE IT system provides a centralized operational control and management system. It minimizes paperwork, streamlines key processes and allows for seamless coordination with all stakeholders.

- **III) Examination and Certification -** TISS-SVE has taken various measures to make use of technology in conducting standardized examinations. There is an Examination Management System on ERP. The execution and management of the examination and certification processes have been streamlined to a grate extent .due to this system.
- This year efforts were made to improve the centralized examiner and invigilator allocation, tracking, management and payment for all hub locations across India.
- The computation of student eligibility for examination based on various parameters was also introduced this year.
- The process of the question paper generation was improved by introducing features to improve question bank tagging and question paper verification.
- The answer sheets of these examinations were uploaded on the cloud app of the online assessment system and the assessors checked the same online. A total 33911 answer sheets uploaded in June 2019 and 45471 answer sheets uploaded in December 2019.
- Automated generation of results and grade cards has been introduced in this year. This helped to declare the results of the 600 plus batches within a month after completion of examinations.

The semester examinations were conducted in June 2019 and December 2019. The details are as follows:

IV) Vocational Aptitude System (VAS) and Counselling Services :

- The key achievement in this year is the pilot testing of Vocational Aptitude System (VAS). Separate battery of tests have been developed for each vertical. The test development process is nearing completion and will be ready for launch soon. The tests will be administered through a software enabled system. This system will help students to understand their own aptitude and select an appropriate course.
- Counselling services Currently there are 39 empanelled counsellors at 45 locations. They conducted 850 plus sessions at various hubs. Last year there were 25 counsellors located at 24 locations and more than 300 sessions were conducted. Efforts were made this year to reach out to maximum students.

As of now 75 to 80% of the total students are being covered by the counsellors across verticals Efforts are being made to reach out to all the students at the earliest.

V) Marketing: The marketing team is taking a range of initiatives to reach to prospective students, and to get associated with industry partners and seek financial support for needy students under CSR.

- This year the marketing team initiated a variety of branding and acquisition campaigns through digital marketing tools and platforms. E.g. TISS SVE is introduced through the College Duniya portal for branding and acquisition purposes.
- To expedite the marketing process two agencies have been empanelled who are together responsible for managing the verticals through various platforms like Facebook, Instagram, LinkedIn and Twitter. This has helped to generate a good amount of student leads pan India.
- "Central Mobilisation Seminars" were conducted in a few major cities like Mumbai, Pune to generate possible leads.
- Apart from this the team is in the process of meeting industry partners and explore the possibility to get associated with them as Skill Knowledge Providers. In addition, they are exploring the possibility of enrolling their employees in SVE courses.
- TISS SVE is exploring the possibility of getting financial support to the needy students in the form of scholarship. In some verticals like Healthcare, Child Care, students do not get stipend in the first year. In some cases they never get the stipend. The support is highly required for such students. So TISS SVE, in collaboration with the National CSR Hub of TISS is in the process of getting connected with industry partners and exploring the possibility to get support through CSR funds.
- Details of support received from various organisations are mentioned next section.

Collaboration with Organisations for Support of the Students

- A) CLP India Ltd CLP India Ltd. is a Hong Kong based company that started its operations in India in the year 2002. The company works in the energy sector and has its plants in Renewable Energy Sector in various parts of the country too. The company has given its CSR funds to TISS SVE to support the fees of the economically weaker students. Through this the scholarship will be given to the first year students. Students studying in the first year of the four verticals, i.e., Renewable Energy, Healthcare, Dialysis Technology and Geriatric Care will be considered for the scholarship. The amount of scholarship will be approximately 50% of the fees.
- B) HCL Foundation Scholarship: HCL Foundation was established in 2011 as the corporate social responsibility arm of HCL. HCL Foundation has given funds to TISS SVE to support 150 underprivileged youth in Noida who will be enrolled in the Healthcare courses. Eighty percent fees of these students will be paid from the HCL Foundation Funds.
- C) Navajbai Ratan Tata Trust: The Tata Trusts have developed a profound understanding of the challenges in the education sector as well as of the needs of various communities and stakeholders across regions. NRTT supported the social sector verticals of SVE – Child Care and Geriatric Care – for a period of five years with a grant of Rs. 2.35 Crores. The grant period concluded in November 2019.
- D) Air India Express Limited (AIXL): AIXL's CSR funds various projects for the development of children, women and weaker sections of the society. Skill development and education is AIXL's one of the key focus areas.

They have been providing scholarship to the students of Diploma in Geriatric Care and B.Voc. in Travel and Tourism programs since the last three years.

E) Ganga Sharan (Minnie) Charitable Trust: This is a charitable family trust. The mandate is to provide support to the vulnerable and needy sections of society for their educational and social advancement. The trust has been providing scholarship to Diploma in Geriatric Care students for the last two years.

Partnership with Tata Motors as Skill Knowledge Provider

Tata Motors is a leading global automobile manufacturing company which was established in year 1945. Their employee strength is 80000 plus and they have 6600 sales and service points. The company manufactures cars, utility vehicles, trucks, buses and defense vehicles. Now they are in the production of e-vehicles too. Tata Motors has entered into partnership agreement with TISS SVE as a Skill Knowledge Provider (SKP) this year. MoU was signed on 27th Feb 2020 at Tata Motors Ltd., Pune by Prof. Neela Dabir, Dean TISS SVE and Mr. Sitaram Kandi, Corporate HR Tata Motors Ltd. The master agreement includes provision for adding on various Pan-India locations. Student interns will be enrolled this year at Pune (both passenger and commercial vehicles plant), as well as at Jamshedpur, Lucknow and Sanand for B.Voc. Operations and B.Voc. Automotive.

Other Initiatives

I) Women and Gender Development Cell (WGDC) - A Women and Gender Cell (WGDC) has been constituted as per the UGC regulations at Tata Institute of Social Sciences. This is for addressing the complaints of sexual harassment and work to create an environment for gender amity. The scope of intervention of WGDC is the Mumbai campus of TISS. It cannot reach out to so many hubs of SVE at Pan India level. So SVE - WGDC Core Committee has been established in May 2019. The Committee will function as a grievance redressal mechanism to address all complaints of sexual harassment faced by students at hub locations and at skill knowledge providers. The Internal Complaints Committees (ICC) under SVE WGDC have been set up at nodal locations in the country - i.e., Mumbai, Delhi, Patna, Ahmedabad, Calicut, Chennai, Jaipur, and Trivandrum. These committees consist of one or two hub representatives, one external member who has experience to work with women and on gender issues as well as a Senior Manager from TISS SVE.

The training programmes for these members on gender sensitization and operational systems of ICC were conducted at TISS SVE and at the eight locations.

II) Staff Development - Staff Development programmes helps in improving the efficiency and the work culture of the organisation. In this year following staff development activities were conducted.

Talentspring: SVE has launched the leadership coaching initiative "Talentspring" for high potential executives for strengthening their leadership competencies keeping in view the organisational need to sustain and grow in the long run. This is being conducted by Ms Nirmala Subbamurthy, Director, Ascent Leadership and Management Consultants Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad.

"Talentspring" Coaching is a year-long exercise planned between the Coach and the Coachee. Twelve one-hour individual sessions between the Coach and Coachee on a one-to-one basis are being conducted every month.

The main sessions were conducted in July 2019 & Jan 2020 for 11 participants.

- **III) Other Events :** A few activities were conducted for the purpose of team building. This includes celebration of Independence Day and Womens' Day as well as a picnic and an annual party.
- a) Common induction of new students A common induction programme of the new students in Mumbai was organised in 3 sessions at TISS campus in August 2019. Around 1000 students of various verticals (Healthcare, Dialysis Technology, BFSI, Child Care and MEPS) attended this induction. Prof Dabir addressed the students. Dr. Suhas Gangurde, Ex CEO, Godrej Hospital and Sushrusha Hospital guided students on this occasion. A few passed out students shared their experiences.
- b) **Certificate Distribution Ceremony** Certificate Distribution ceremony was organised for B.Voc. passed out students on November 8, 2019. A total of 170 students of Dialysis Technology, Healthcare, Agriculture, BFSI and Child Care were awarded degrees during this ceremony. The first and second rank students were felicitated by giving the medals. Students shared their experiences on this occasion. Prof Neela Dabir, Dean, SVE addressed the gathering.

IV) Publications and Reports :

a) Rockefellor Foundation Fellowship received by Prof. Neela Dabir, Dean, SVE

In July 2019, Prof. Dabir received Rockefellor Foundation Academic Writing Fellowship for three weeks. Prof. Dabir and Dr Leena Wadia had written a joint proposal for this fellowship. The Rockefellor Foundation Academic Writing Project included a stay at the Bellagio Centre of the Foundation in Italy for completing a writing work.

During this fellowship both of them wrote a monograph titled, "A blueprint for the integration of vocational education into mainstream higher education in India, in the context of the upcoming New Education Policy". This monograph is based on the experiences of setting up a new scalable model of vocational education in the higher education space. The School of Vocational Education has showcased a work integrated training model for the country. The presentation based on the SVE model was well received and appreciated by other International Fellows in the residency programme.

This monograph will be sent for publication after fine-tuning the draft prepared during the Residency at Bellagio, Italy.

b) Writing assignment for TVET in India for UNESCO

This year, Prof. Dabir and Dr. Leena Wadia received another writing assignment from UNESCO. They will be writing a report titled "The State of Education Report for India 2020-Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET)".

This will encompass the current status of Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) in India. This report is expected to be ready by August 2020.

c) Publications of a Project Report on Employability Skills for Youth and Women from Denotified and Nomadic Tribes This project was taken up by Prof. Medha Somaiya under the guidance of Prof. Neela Dabir. It was an action-based research intervention, which assessed the outcomes on the parameters of employability quotient on the principles laid down by STEPS (Self-Management, Teamwork, Enterprising, Problem Solving, and Speaking & Listening) by Strycharczyk and Bosworth (2016). On the basis of findings of employability quotient the youth and women were provided training in four domain areas in consonance with their aptitude. These were Retail Services, Mobile Repairing, Basic Information Technology and Computer Hardware.

The project has been able to demonstrate the need for focused vocational education programmes for skilling the youth and women from marginalized sections of the Indian population. The project was jointly supported by Action Aid India, Commonwealth Education Media Centre for Asia and NSDC. The logistic support in the project was provided by Dr. Prerna Sharma.

A report of the project has been published by the School of Vocational Education.








TISS-SVE Organogram

Extracurricular activities conducted by the hubs for fun and learn -

Hub -Shri Ramesh Prakash Samajik Santhan Samiti, Itarsi

Workshop on Landscaping: Mr. Sunil Sachaan, a leading landscaper of Itarsi conducted a 5-day landscaping workshop for students in March 2020. Students were taken to the field for exposure and they were assigned field work post-workshop to understand landscaping in real scenarios.

Making of Herbal Gulaal: This is the second year where students have made herbal gulaal from flower, leaf and other extracts; this was sold to hospitals, schools and general population and was appreciated by people.

Preparation of Hand Sanitizer: As a part of community relief work 10 litres of hand sanitizer was made as per WHO guidelines. This sanitizer was distributed to the police personnel.

Saplings of Vegetables: In the month of May 2020 saplings of 300+ vegetables were grown and distributed in the rural slum community near the hub area; this was done as a part of food sufficiency for the area.

Life-skill session: In the beginning of session 2019-20 in July, a Life Skill session was conducted by Ms. Piyuli Ghosh with lot of fun and goal-setting exercises.

German technique hugelkutur: German technique hugelkutur is being practiced at the hub premises for conservation of water and agri-waste which in-turn increases the soil fertility.

Visit by Foreign Delegates: In Dec. 2019, delegates of Global March by Ekta Parishad stayed at our hub location and we had the privilege to have a session with them on various domains like labour rights, and land rights.

Hariyali Mahotsav: Hariyali Mahotsav of Chhatisgarh was celebrated in the month of August 2019 with lot of fun and other activities.

Dholak Music Competition: It was organized in August 2019 for the students of a hub.

Extracurricular activities conducted by Hub - Mitraniketan:

Ektara 2019 Art Festival - This festival was conducted on October 9th& 10th 2019. Students from all batches had participated in the event. There were 23 activities (e.g., essay writing, poetry writing, drawing, dance, and poster-making) which were conducted in these two days. On the festival culmination day, an award ceremony was conducted. A trophy was awarded to the winning teams. Other students were awarded with certificates for their exceptional participation.

The stand alone dialysis facility run by THANAL is the biggest of its kind in India equipped with 140 dialysis machines functioning in seven units at Vatakara, Arikkulam near Koyilandy, Kallachi near Nadapuram, Chaliyam, Thaliparamba, Chemencheri and Mahe by doing around 8,000 dialysis every month, and thus benefiting more than 600 underprivileged patients.

- The Healthcare courses at Diploma and Advance Diploma level (first and second year of B.Voc) have been approved by Maharashtra state paramedical council. The approval of B.Voc is in process.
- 2) Content revamp of Healthcare Courses The three B.Voc. courses (B.Voc. in Medical Lab Technology, Patient Care Management, Medical Imaging Technology) and Diploma in X Ray and CT Scan are being implemented since last 3 4 years.
